**PROPOSAL FOR EXTENDING TIMELINE FOR
POST-2017 HOOVER POWER ALLOCATION PROCESS**

At the February 17, 2015 regular meeting of the Arizona Power Authority (APA or Authority) Commission, the Commission adopted a timeline for the Post-2017 Hoover Power Allocation Process consistent with section R12-14-201 of the Arizona Administrative Code. According to that timeline, applications for electric service were due on April 27, 2015. It has become necessary to extend the application deadline and adjust the schedule for the remaining dates, including the date of the Public Information Conference, the Public Comment Conference, the Notice of Proposed Allocation, and the presentation of the draft Power Sales Contract.

The Authority has noticed a special Commission meeting scheduled for Tuesday, April 28, 2015. At the special meeting, the Commission will consider the following options for adjusting the regulatory timeline for the Post-2017 Hoover Power Allocation Process. Option 1 is based on a two-week extension of the application deadline, and Option 2 is based on a three-week extension.

The Commission will accept public comments on the adjusted schedules at the special Commission meeting on April 28, 2015.
